Richard Anders is a long-time entrepreneur. Currently he is a managing director of Rubin/Anders Scientific. Prior to this, he founded Jurisoft, a software company which he sold to Lexis/Nexis, and published newspapers about the technology industry, including Boston Digital Industry and New York Digital Industry. Mr. Anders is a trustee of the Boston Museum of Science, a member of the MIT/Harvard Medical School HST program advisory council where he helps teach a course on the biomedical enterprise, and a trustee of the Boston Biomedical Research Institute. He is a member of the Institutional Review Board at the Dana Farber Cancer Center, which reviews clinical trials for the hospital. Mr. Anders has been a venture capitalist at Still River Fund, focusing on life sciences. He founded the Launchpad angel group and more recently, Mass Medical Angels, one of the only angel groups in the country focused exclusively on life sciences. Mr. Anders is a summa cum laude graduate of Harvard College in mathematics and holds a J.D. from Harvard Law School.
