Dr. Ying Mei is currently a Postdoctoral Associate in the laboratory of Institute Professor Robert Langer at MIT. He received his B.S. degree in Polymer Chemistry and Physics from Wuhan University in China in 1994. He obtained his Ph.D. in Chemistry of Materials from the Polytechnic University in 2003 in New York under the supervision of Professor Richard A. Gross. He was granted the 2003 Presidential Green Chemistry Award for his Ph.D. research on the enzyme catalyzed polymerization. Prior to his current appointment at MIT, he worked as a guest researcher at the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) in Gaithersburg, Maryland, where he utilized spatially defined gradient generation technology to examine cell/materials interactions in a combinatorial manner.
