

\$150,000 CIMIT Prize for Primary Healthcare

The CIMIT Prize for Primary Healthcare is a national innovation competition encouraging engineering students to develop creative technological solutions that have great potential to enhance the delivery of care in the frontlines of medicine.

Participants describe proposed innovations through a Letter of Intent due by January 17, 2011.

Ten finalists are selected to submit a full proposal in February.

Finalists are each awarded \$10,000 to defray expenses in preparing a full submission.

First, second and third place winners will be selected from finalists' submissions in June.

Top three winners will receive \$150,000, \$100,000 and \$50,000, respectively.
